Old Lifeguard Station To Be Repaired

According to the Outer Banks Sentinel, the old lifeguard station just south of Oregon Inlet will shortly undergo significant exterior renovations. This station, built in 1897, has been left to the elements since 1990 when a new station was built on the north side of



Oregon Inlet. Parts of this historic building has been damaged by moving sand dunes over the last fifteen years. The purpose of the renovation is to get it out of the sand and have it ready for a future interior renovation. If this does not occur soon then the building is in danger of being consumed by the moving dune.

It continues to be a buyer's market on the Outer Banks. Contracts written during the first half of 2008 were just under 2007's numbers. The first sign of a possible turn in the market started in May. Inventory was at its lowest seasonally adjusted point in four years. A key indicator to watch to determine a market change is the absorption rate. When this indicator goes down the market is turning in the seller's favor. Scott Team Realty's sales continue to be steady at a

Summer Pompano Fishing

Summer and early fall are the best times of year for pompano fishing. When the surf is clear and in the mid to upper 70's pompano can usually be found right at the edge of the surf. Unlike many types of surf fishing, these fish are best caught on light tackle in the breakers close to the beach. Most times a small hook baited with a mole crab, (sometimes called a sand flea),

with less than an ounce of weight works just fine. A cast less than ten feet into a hole next to a sand bar will usually be enough if the fish are there. A two pound fish is a very large pompano for this area but it will fight like a ten pound fish! Hold on to the rod because these fish bite quick and are famous for taking the bait. These fish are delicious fried!
