was listed in the MLS and the listing firm guaranteed that amount as compensation. As of August 17, that information is not as easy to find. Not knowing that information makes the true cost of purchasing a home unknown. Let me explain...if you are a buyer and have an agent helping you with your purchase then that agent expects to get paid. In the rare instances where the seller won't pay, then the buyer's agent will need to collect it from the buyer. Of course, prior to August 17, the agent was paid by the listing agent. After August 17 they may or may not be paid by the listing agent. Not knowing that information up front is a major disservice to buyers nationwide. #### **OBX Real Estate Market Update**

There are still real estate transactions happening on the Outer Banks. However, the number of properties sold this year through the Outer Banks Association of Realtor's MLS system is lower than recent years. In fact, sales so far for this calendar year are the lowest they've been since 2014. Why is that? Lower inventory may have an effect. The number of properties for sale is still lower than in pre-covid years. Some buyers are also

anticipating a drop in interest rates, so they don't have as much motivation to make a purchase now. There is a fine line between a well-priced property and an overpriced property here. Those buyers that are ready to act are very price sensitive. If they perceive a property is priced right, then they'll move quick. ## **Cape Hatteras Lighthouse Makeover**

The Hatteras Lighthouse is having extensive work done to protect this national treasure and navigational beacon. This restoration project will last over one year. Highlights of this restoration include new paint inside and out, metal parts inspected and damaged parts replaced, repointed masonry and landscaping. As of this writing, the lighthouse is encircled by scaffolding. Even though touring the lighthouse is not possible during this renovation period, it's worth checking out this unusual sight. Besides the unique color pattern, this lighthouse blinks every seven and a half seconds so mariners can tell where they are at night. It is also the tallest brick lighthouse in America. It should be back open for visitors to climb in the spring of 2026. 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## Lost Colony Finding

According to the First Colony Foundation Website, the copper earring found last year at the Elizabethan Garden's archeological dig came from European copper. Other period artifacts have also been found. Archeologists believe this site was abandoned by the Native Americans prior to 1587. That's when the Lost Colony arrived. They've ruled out the Native Americans receiving this earring from the Spanish since they did not explore this far north. As a result, they believe this earring was given to an Algonquian in the previous English expedition of 1584.
